Projects

Gemco is currently in process of the realization of greenfield foundry facilities in the above mentioned countries. By the end of 2017, the new constructions must be completed and ready to be transformed into running factories with production lines of new machinery.

The internship

During your internship you become a member of the project team and you will assist the project manager and site manager on site.

The site manager is responsible for the installation and commissioning -by suppliers as well as customers- of products and machineries, at the precise time and the right place under safe circumstances on-site.

He cares for a smooth organization, for the logistic processes and the safety of all employees. The site manager attends the site for a longer period of time. He is the linking pin between the customer, suppliers and his Gemco colleagues in the Netherlands.

The project manager is basically working in the Netherlands and attends the site frequently.

The student will be located on site and will support the site manager, the project manager and the other colleagues working for the specific project. Depending on the skills and objective of the student, the work may vary from organizing meetings with customers, assisting in the supervision of suppliers to setting up and implementing logistic plans.

Being on the site, you will learn about what it takes to build a factory: the engineering, the different process equipment, planning, logistics, administration, control, safety, contact with customers, suppliers and locals, etcetera.

Profile

You are studying mechanical engineering (bachelor) and you would like to increase your theoretical knowledge with a practical (learning on the job) international internship.

You can cope with stress, you are energetic, you can work in a team, you are client oriented and you are willing to travel and stay abroad for a longer period of time.

You must be able to communicate in English in speech and writing. Knowledge of Spanish, Polish or German is an added value.

Period of internship

During the period January 2018 until the summer of 2018 (and maybe longer) we are able to offer an internship to multiple students. We expect the duration of each of the internships to be four to six months.

We offer

- An allowance of € 300,- gross per month.
- During your stay abroad we will reimburse all expenses for travel and accommodation.
